Ongoing formation of musicians, cantors and choir members

Coordination of musicians for weekly and Holy Day Masses

Recruit, train and schedule all Liturgical Ministers

Videotape Mass for Public Access TV each week

Order supplies
(candles, wine, altar bread, flowers, decorations)
