### **St. Anthony's Bread**

Thank you for your prayers and interest. Because of your support, St. Anthony's Bread responded to 66 requests and five commitments in May, 2010. SAB helped 53 households with partial payment of rent or utilities. We helped pay for car repairs, medication, household goods, diapers, a cell phone bill, a bus ticket, and a bus pass. Among the individuals we helped 19 were disabled or ill, 35 were single parents, 14 were unemployed or had reduced hours, four were victims of domestic violence, and three were homeless. There were 123 children and four pregnancies in the families served in May.
